

2 referees per proposal appointed 2-3 weeks before meeting

2012 meetings: 1-2 Feb and 31 Oct – 1 Nov [57 proposals; 23 in 2009]

INTC recommends # of 8h shifts (& pot) to Research Board – no priority

Maximum 6 pages for physics case of proposal

2012 UPDATE

Radioactive beam shifts: 579 shifts scheduled, out of 1060.

New equipment: MAYA, CRIS, Optical TPC, Lund scat. chamber, ...

New beams: ^{72}Kr , ^{123}Cd , $^{140,142}\text{Sm}$, ^{221}Rn , ...

Long Shutdown: ISOLDE Dec 17 2012 – end June 2014
(no winter shutdown 2014/2015)

HIE-ISOLDE – delay in cryoplant procurement, starts mid 2015
(5.5 MeV.A – 8 MeV.A)

TSR approved by Research Board; new hall & transfer lines 2016

(n_TOF second beam line also approved)
