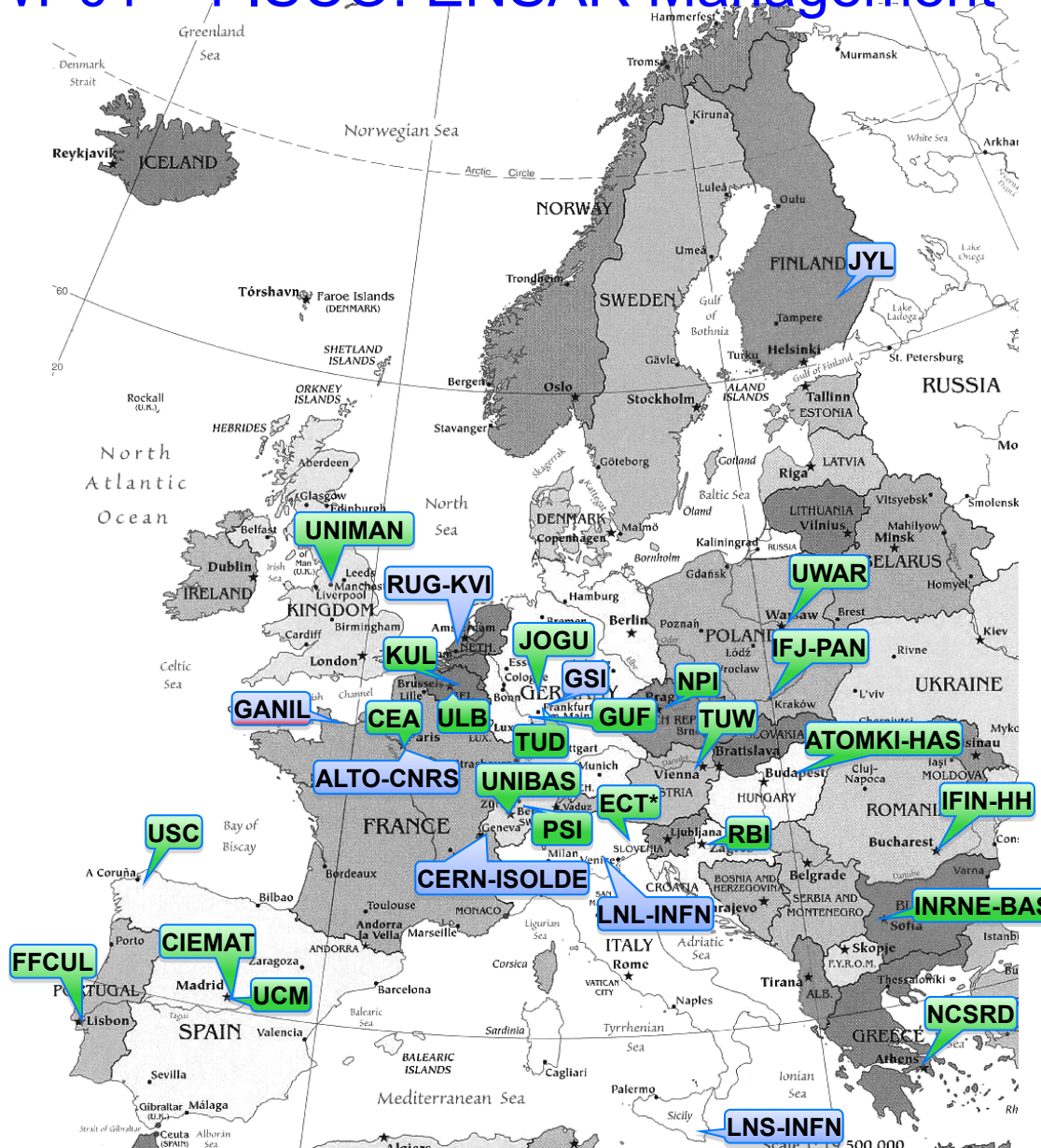
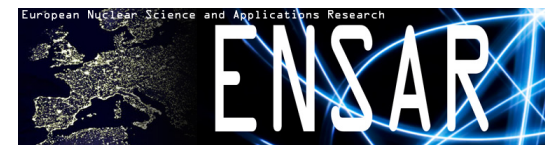

FISCO = Financial and SCientific Organisation
= the effective consortium management for the ENSAR community

- ➔ **Coordination** of all technical, scientific, financial, administrative, contractual and legal activities of ENSAR (reports to EC, etc.)
- ➔ **Dissemination** of knowledge and outreach activities to society (plan for dissemination of knowledge, plan for raising public awareness, website for the layman)
- ➔ Development and maintenance of common project-related **databases**
- ➔ Establishment of an overarching **Facility Coordinating Group** (FCG): mutual information, coordination, harmonisation and exchange of best practices between the ENSAR research infrastructures

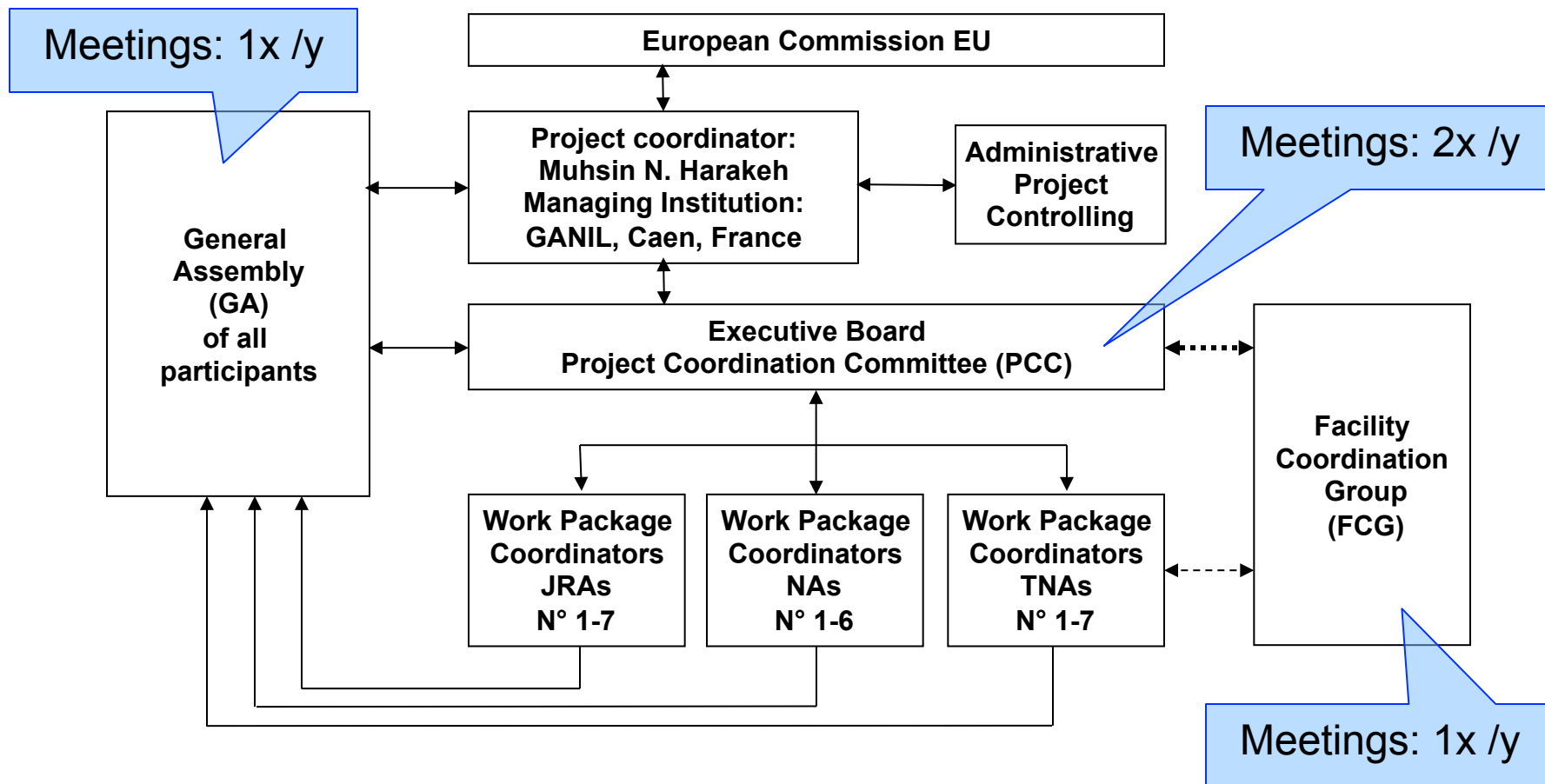
